Directions to Discovery Ski Area

From the east:

Take Interstate 90 to exit 208 onto Highway 1 west towards Anaconda (8 miles). Continue west on Highway 1 for 20 miles to Georgetown Lake. Turn right (north) at the Discovery Ski Area and St. Timothy's Chapel signs. Continue north for 4.5 miles to the ski area.

From the west:

Take Interstate 90 to exit 153 onto Highway 1 east towards Philipsburg (26 miles). Remain on Highway 1 past Philipsburg towards Georgetown Lake. Two miles past the Georgetown Lake dam turn left (north) at the Discovery Ski Area and St. Timothy's Chapel signs. Continue north for 4.5 miles to the ski area..
