RACE DESCRIPTION:

The 8 Hours of Labor is back for 2009 and is being hosted by Homestake Lodge on Homestake Pass near Butte, MT. Racers may either compete as individuals or in teams of any size. Each lap is approximately 7 miles in length. Terrain is a combination of logging roads, trails, and single track suitable for most riders.

DIRECTIONS:

To get to Homestake Lodge, take the Homestake exit from I-90 at the top of Homestake pass and turn south for a short distance, turn onto FS 240 road for 3 miles, paralleling I-90 eastward. The road is manageable for most vehicles. Post race awards will be done at the lodge.

All Pros must have an international license and all Cat 1 riders must have a USAC annual license.

- 3 Race Day Registration Available - \$50
- 4 Racing Starts at 9:00 AM

- 6 Promoters reserve the right to combine race classes if minimum number of riders is not met.
- 7 One-day licenses will be available for \$5 for category 2 and 3 riders.
- 8 Prizes must be collected at Awards Ceremony (no winnings will be mailed).
- 9 Official - David Wagner.

PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd men and women in the solo category and 1st, 2nd, 3rd in the two person relay category

VENUE:

Homestake lodge is a cross country ski area, with a day lodge and hostel style bunk rooms with accommodations up to 16. Camping sites are available, and like the bunks, must be pre-reserved by directly contacting Homestake Lodge. Additional meal tickets are \$7.50 (1 meal ticket included with each race entry). Beds may be reserved at Homestake Lodge for Friday and Saturday nights at \$20/bed/night, camping is available for \$10/tent/night. All registrants receive a tote bag and coffee mug.
