The Course: Located in the North Higgins section of Downtown Missoula. It's a six corner "L" shaped course. The start/finish is in front of Adventure Cycling Association (150 E. Pine St.). The streets involved are Pine, Pattee, Railroad, Higgins, Spruce, and Ryman.

Rules: All USA Cycling rules apply. Racers must wear helmets while racing and warming up/down.

Directions: Registration, staging, restrooms, etc. will be at the Adventure Cycling Association (150 E Pine St). Off of I-90 take the Orange Street Exit. Go under the bridge and take a left on Spruce St. The course intersects Spruce at Ryman St., two blocks from the turn. There is no specific parking area. The city of Missoula offers free on street parking on Sundays. Find a good spot close to the course and walk to registration.
