



Homestake XC Mountain Bike Race

Saturday June 5, 2010
Held under USAC permit

RACE DESCRIPTION:

The race will be held at Homestake Lodge, a cross country ski area at the top of Homestake pass on I-90, just east of Butte, on Forest Service land backing the XC ski area. The course is an 8-mile loop comprised of double-track and single track. The course will be fast, rolling terrain that will suit all around riders. Registration is from 9:30 AM – 10:30 A.M; the race will begin at 11:00 A.M. following a short kids race (kids race first to allow parents to run beside their kids of needed).

DIRECTIONS:

To get to Homestake Lodge, take the Homestake exit from I-90 at the top of Homestake pass and turn south for a short distance, turn onto FS 240 road for 3 miles, paralleling I-90 eastward. The road is manageable for most vehicles. Post race awards will be done at the lodge.

All Pros must have an international license and all Cat 1 riders must have a USAC annual license.

All USAC Rules Apply

1. Juniors Free (no charge for kids race either) Last date of online registration Sunday June 21.
2. Race Day Registration - \$25
3. Racing Starts at 11:00 AM
4. Promoters reserve the right to combine race classes if minimum number of riders is not met.
5. One-day licenses will be available for \$ for category 2 and 3 riders.
6. Pro and category 1 racers must present their annual license to register in these categories.
7. Prizes for all categories. Prizes must be collected at Awards Ceremony (no winnings will be mailed).

Cash prizes for top three placing in male and female Pro, cat 1 and cat 2 adult groups. Non-cash prizes for top three places in cat 3 and junior.
